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**REPORT OF LABORATORY EXAMINATION**

1. The evidence and references received are located in Appendix 1.

2. **Methods**

DNA was extracted, amplified and analyzed for autosomal Short Tandem Repeats (STRs) and mitochondrial DNA.

3. **Results**

The autosomal STR results and statistical calculations are listed in Appendix 2.

The mitochondrial DNA sequence information and database search results are listed in Appendix 3.

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**4. Conclusions: Autosomal STRs and Mitochondrial DNA:**

Based upon nuclear and mitochondrial DNA analysis, AFDIL Specimen Nos. 46A (E-211, Q125) and 98A (E-3, Q100.1) are consistent with originating from Colette MacDonald. Based upon nuclear DNA analysis, Kimberley MacDonald (AFDIL Specimen Nos. 196A, and 196G) and Kristen MacDonald (AFDIL Specimen Nos. 197A and 197E) are excluded as being the contributors of AFDIL Specimen Nos. 46A and 98A.

**Conclusions: Autosomal STRs:**

**INTERPRETATION KEY**

DNA is extracted from selected specimens. Multiple copies of a specific region of mitochondrial DNA (mtDNA) are generated using the polymerase chain reaction (PCR). This region is known to have variability within the human population. The predominant base composition (or sequence) is determined using automated DNA sequencing chemistry and gel electrophoresis. The base composition consists of adenine (A), cytosine (C), guanine (G), and thymine (T). Sequence information is analyzed to determine variability when compared to a published standard sequence (Anderson, et al. 1981. *Nature* 290:457-465). The sequence of the submitted evidentiary material is compared to the sequence obtained from the reference(s).

1. The confirmed region refers to the base positions within the mtDNA genome that are reported.
2. The following notations may apply:
  - a. The appropriate letter (e.g. T-C) designates a transition or transversion polymorphism.
  - b. A "D" designates a deletion.
  - c. A number following a decimal point designates an insertion. The specific base insertion is designated by the appropriate letter (e.g. 315.1 C).
  - d. A "N" designates a position that could not be confirmed.
3. The table provides information regarding the number of confirmed bases generated and the number of times each sequence has been observed in the following databases (sequence ranges vary): African American (AFAM), African-Sierra Leone (AFSL), Egyptian (AFEG), Caucasian (CAUC), Hispanic (HIS), Japanese (JPN), Korean (KOR), Thai (THAI), Chinese/Taiwanese (CHN/TAI), Navajo (NAV), Apache (APA), Guam (GUAM), Indian (IND), and Pakistani (PAK).




